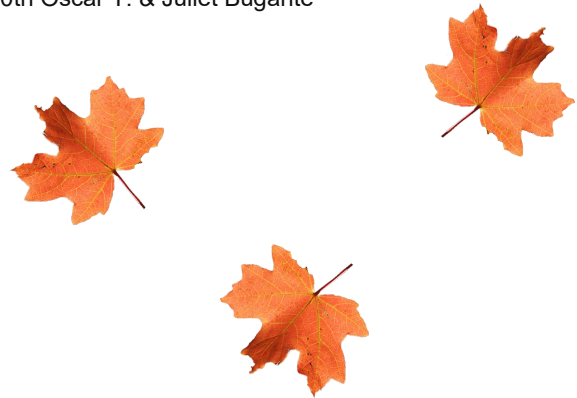

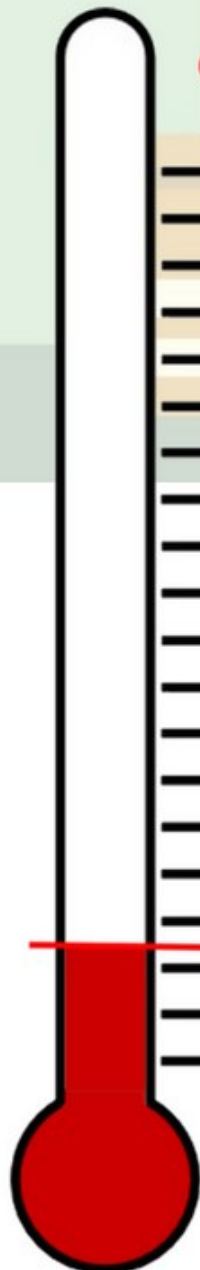

The board, not the membership, is authorized to fill any vacancy at a regular board meeting - without notice - as long as there is a majority of remaining board members present. The board has, at times, chosen the former IPGK to fill a spot vacated by the new GK but this is not required - it is subject to a vote of the board.

The Secretary of the board is responsible for all election matters, tracking the board members and their terms, notifying the general membership of the annual meeting (including election of three 3-year members), etc.
