FATHER MAGUIRE COLUMBUS CLUB, INC.

The Columbus Club board is comprised of 11 members. Nine of those members are elected each year for staggered three year terms starting in October of the year elected and ending in October three years later. The other two members are automatically the current GK and the immediate PGK. Their terms on the board are from July 1 of their term as GK until June 30 two years later when they are no longer the IPGK. The board, not the membership, is authorized to fill any vacancy at a regular board meeting - without notice - as long as there is a majority of remaining board members present. The board has, at times, chosen the former IPGK to fill a spot vacated by the new GK but this is not required - it is subject to a vote of the board. The Secretary of the board is responsible for all election matters, tracking the board members and their terms, notifying the general membership of the annual meeting (including election of three 3-year members), etc.
